Meet Alyssa

Her life changed when she was matched with Blondie, a Dog Guide from Lions Foundation of Canada.

"Blondie has helped me to become more independent at home, school and out with my friends and family. I know that when I need help with something as simple as opening the door to the library at school, Blondie is there to help" says Alyssa.

"She has been there whenever I have needed help, like when I fell out of bed and was stuck in between my bed and a chair. I might have been trapped there for a while if it weren't for Blondie. She alerted my mom in an instant!"

Blondie and other Special Skills Dog Guides can be trained to open doors, fetch dropped items and bark for help when needed.

Gaining Independence

In addition to Special Skills Dog Guides, Lions Foundation of Canada trains three other types of Dog Guides: Seizure Response, Canine Vision and Hearing Ear Dog Guides. Much like Alyssa, Lesleigh has gained more independence and a greater sense of security through her Seizure Response Dog Guide Ashton.

"Ashton has given me the security of knowing he is here. When I have a seizure, I know that he will get me help either by barking or going to get someone for me. Then I know he stays with me, because I can feel him licking my face," says Lesleigh.

"He's given me my life. Every single day I can get up and handle my day. He's always there for me."



A New Outlook

For someone like Fred who is visually impaired, having a Dog Guide like Max has given him a new outlook on life. *"Max takes away the stress. No longer am I second guessing whether or not I can go out,"* says Fred. *"Max acts as my eyes. He helps me with daily activities like avoiding obstacles that we may encounter while we're out walking."*

Canine Vision Dog Guides like Max can be trained to assist with travel on public transportation and navigate through busy environments like downtown streets and the mall.



Helping To Make Life Easier

Gwen, a Hearing Ear Dog Guide, helps make life easier for Gaelen. *"She helps people know that I am deaf,"* Gaelen explains. Gwen helps Gaelen with everyday sounds, and in some instances dangerous situations. *"Gwen wakes me up in the morning for school and work,"* says Gaelen.

"She is also great to have for safety reasons. She is there to alert me to vital sounds like when the fire alarm is going off."
